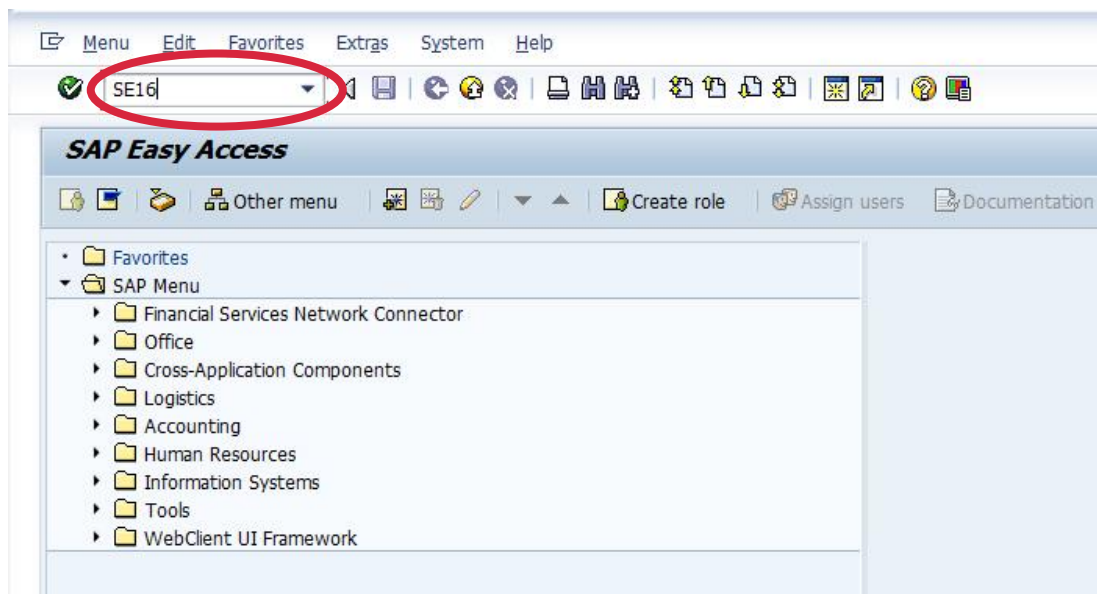
zap Free

With zap Free you can unlock any zap audit dataset with less than 50 000 BKPF entries free of charge. Use this tutorial to determine the table size of the BKPF in your SAP system.

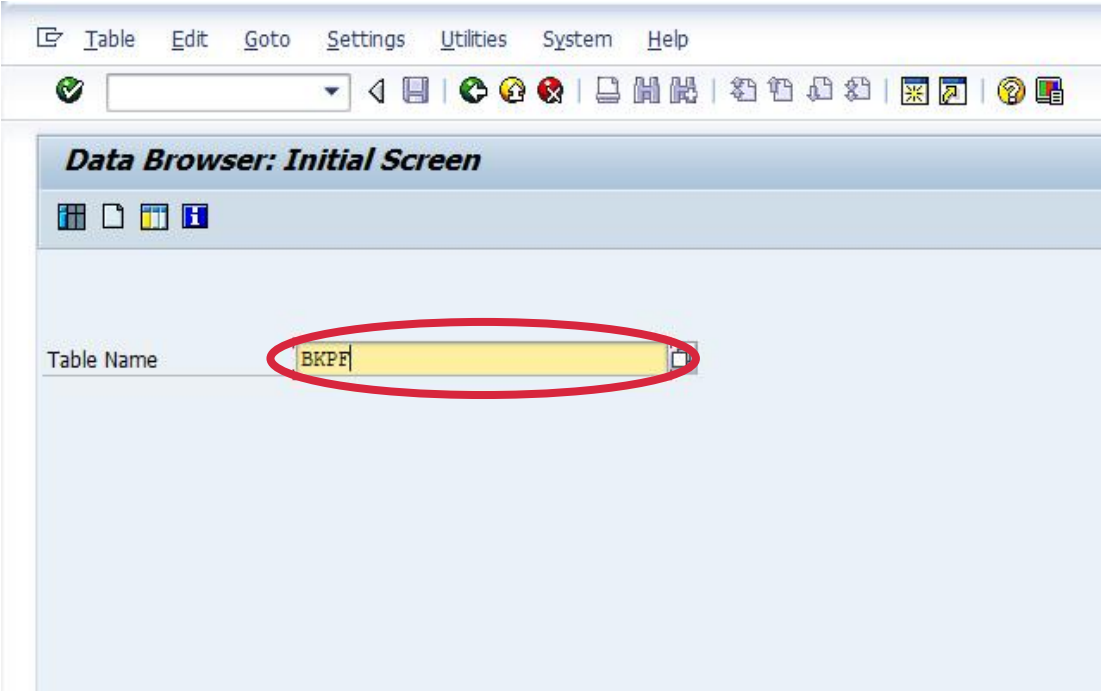
Note: The installation and use of zap Audit as well as the data extraction (also larger data sets with more than 50 000 BKPF entries) are also free of charge.

Determine the size of SAP tables

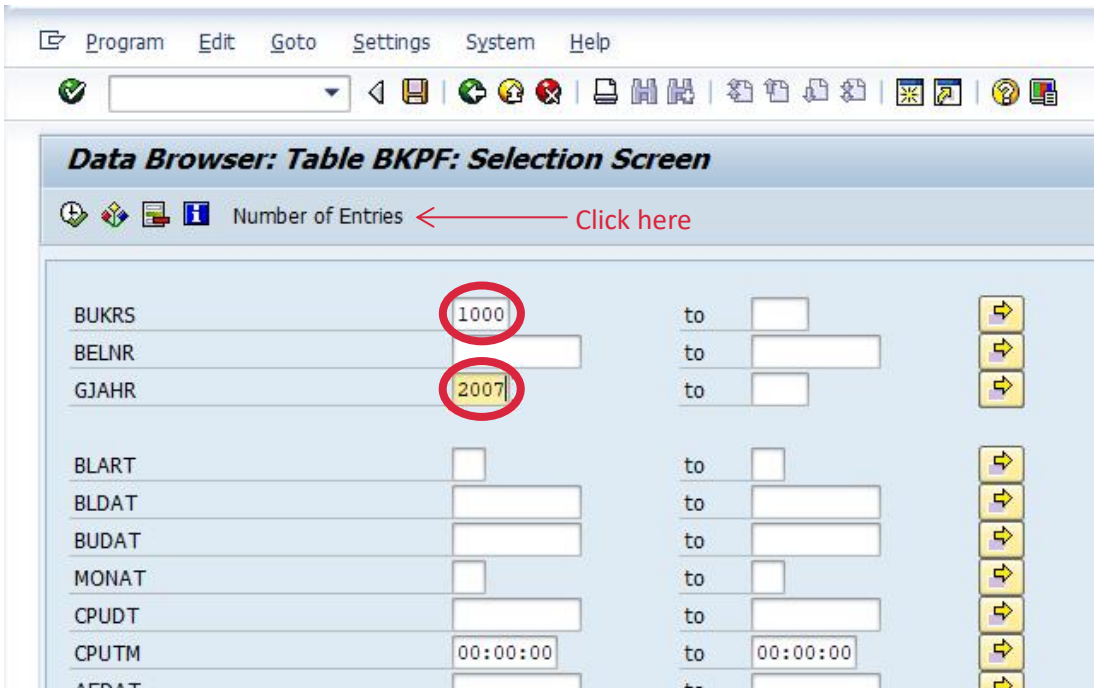
1. Login to SAP Logon (SAP GUI) using your SAP user account.
2. Enter transaction code "SE16" or "SE16n".



3. Enter the name of the table (for example BKPF).



- Limit the table selection to one fiscal year (2007) and company code (1000).



- Click „Number of Entries“. The table size is shown in a new window.
